Appearance

- All children are expected to look smart, with uniform in good repair.
- Children must not come to school with coloured or bleached hair. Hair must either be neat, above the collar and away from the eyes or if longer than shoulder length it must be tied back with a simple navy, black or the school tartan hair band.
- No jewellery to be worn with school uniform.
- Children with pierced ears may only wear small, plain gold or silver ball studs and these must be removed for all sport. Ears should only be pierced at the beginning of a summer holiday.

Name Tapes

- **All clothing** must be clearly named, inside the neck or waistband.
- Shoe labels are required.
- Sports bags & day bags should be named clearly named.
- Waterproof, washable aprons should be named and a large loop sewn in to help children hang aprons on their school peg.
- Swimming caps named on the outside in indelible ink.
