

## FREE EARLY EDUCATION (FEE) FOR 3 AND 4 YEAR OLDS

Dulwich Cranbrook participates in the KCC Free Early Education (FEE) scheme which provides funding for all children, from the term following their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday until the term in which they reach their 5<sup>th</sup> birthday, for up to a maximum of 15 hours per week, 38 weeks per year. Dependent on term dates, the School is usually able to offer 33 or 34 weeks per year in total. To claim the maximum of 15 hours per week, a child will need to attend a minimum of 5 sessions in Nash House, e.g. 5 mornings; 2 full days and 1 morning; 1 full day and 3 mornings. 9 hours per week can be claimed for those attending only 3 sessions or 12 hours per week for those attending only 4 sessions.

Claim declarations are provided by Nash House for parents to complete on a termly basis, before submission to KCC for approval\*

A fully-funded place for a child accessing the 15 hours entitlement can be provided in a separate session from 2.15pm to 5.15 pm, 5 afternoons per week subject to availability. A fully-funded place for a child accessing 30 hours per week can be provided in a separate session from 11.00am to 5.30 pm which includes a free lunch.

Extra sessions cannot be added and children attending these sessions will not be guaranteed a place in Reception the following year. No registration fee or deposit is payable for children accessing only fully-funded hours.
