Appearance

- All children are expected to look smart, with uniform in good repair.
- Children must not come to school with coloured or bleached hair. Hair must either be neat, above the collar and away from the eyes or if longer than shoulder length it must be tied back with a simple navy or the school tartan hair band.
- No jewellery or make-up may be worn with school uniform.
- Children with pierced ears may only wear small, plain gold or silver ball studs and these must be removed for all sport. Ears should only be pierced at the beginning of a summer holiday.
- Shoes must be black leather and fastened with velcro, lace or buckle. Pumps or heels are not permitted.
- Ankle socks must cover the ankle. Sports-style socks are not permitted.

Name Tapes

- **All clothing** must be clearly named, inside the neck or waistband.
- Shoe labels are required.
- Sports bags should be named at both ends with silver or white indelible pen.
- Swimming caps named on the outside in indelible ink.

Dress Code

For all concerts, prize giving, whole school assemblies, the first and last day of each term and any other specified special occasions, the following uniform should be worn:

Years 7 – 11

- Blazer, skirt, blue blouse, jumper, navy tights, black shoes or blazer, mid grey trousers or navy shorts, blue shirt (long or short sleeved), tie, navy socks, black shoes.

Boys require their blazers for all cricket matches.

Passport: There are various trips abroad in Years 7 - 11, so please check that children have a valid, full passport.
